At the time Ricky was racing in a NASCAR Sportsman, a support series to some of the bigger classes. Getting tools to and from pit lane became a challenge. The solution was to put a larger “pit” box on pneumatic tires to handle uneven surfaces and be stable. Other racers noticed, placed orders, and as the saying goes, the rest is history.
